Seeding Meeting -

- Sunday May 2nd at Tatlock Field House Summit (10:30 AM)
(Mandatory meeting...all coaches must attend). Teams will be seeded at this meeting. Please bring scorebooks to the meeting with stats.

Location/Payment of Games/Officials –

- The higher seeded teams will host all first round games.
- Teams that will be playing a first round game must contact Bob Nuse to set up officials for your game. Contact information: bnuse@comcast.net / (609) 731-7515.
- Semi-Finals shall be played on a pre-determined neutral site with the higher seeded team being the home team.
- Semi Finals will be played on May 12, 2010 at 5:30PM and 7:30PM at A. L. Johnson Turf Field.
- Championship Game to be held at A. L. Johnson Turf Field May 14, 2010 at 7:30PM.
- The entry fee is \$200.00. The fee will cover the cost of officials for the Semi – Finals and Finals, the Tournament Awards and one game MVP for each round. It will also cover the supervision costs for the use of the field.
- The Runner-Up Team will receive 30 team certificates.

- The Championship Team will receive 30 team certificates and one team trophy.
